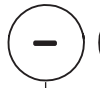
BOTTOM OF UNIT

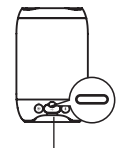

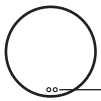

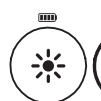

TRUE WIRELESS PAIRING (TWS)

(REQUIRES 2 SPEAKERS)

- 1) Pair one iBT820 unit to your device via Bluetooth.
- 2) Power on the second iBT820 unit.
- 3) Press and hold the Vol + and Play Button for 2 seconds on each unit (speaker light will blink green).
- 4) When both units are linked, the speaker light should flash multiple times, and will announce 'Left Channel/ Right Channel'.
- 5) If TWS linking fails, speaker light flash RED 3 times.
- 6) Both units will link TWS automatically next time both units are powered on within 1 minute of each other.
- 7) To disconnect TrueWireless, reset BT pairing: press & hold Bluetooth Pairing button for 10 seconds.
